

Can't play the audio?

This is because your computer hasn't been set to associate **m3u** files to any **audio player**.

(M3u files allow MP3 files to be streamed, not downloaded).

Resolving this is **quick** and **easy**:

Go to the **Control panel**, find **Folder options** and then **File types** (go straight to *file types* if your computer does not have *folder options*).

Go down the alphabetical list of file types until you find **m3u** files. Then highlight **m3u** and change the default player to an **audio player** you use (e.g. Windows Media player or iTunes).

When you've done this that media player will then be able to play **m3u files**.
